

TECHNICAL DATA

FOREMOST 4888-ES BUG OFF!

- DESCRIPTION: Bug Off is specifically designed to repel Mosquitoes, Chiggers, Ticks, Deer Flies, Black Flies, Gnats and Fleas from exposed skin.
- DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To repel the listed insects, apply just enough repellant to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. To apply to face, spray into hands and rub on. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to hands of young children. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not spray directly onto face. Do not apply over cuts and wounds or irritated skin. Do not allow children to handle this product. When using on children, apply to your own hands & then put it on the child. Repeat as needed. For control of ticks and chiggers, apply to shoe tops, socks, and around openings in clothes. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. Use of this product may cause reactions in rare cases. If you suspect that you or your child is reacting to this product, wash treated skin and call your local poison control center. If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you.

Avoid contact with plastics such as eyeglasses frames, and such fabric as acetate and rayon.

Do not spray in enclosed areas.

PRECAUTIONS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes. Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. After returning indoors, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin. Wash clothing before reuse. Avoid swallowing or inhaling spray. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS. Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flames. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Pesticide Storage: Secure, preferably a locked storage area that is cool and dry. <u>Disposal:</u> If empty: place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. If partially filled: call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Do not puncture or incinerate!
