DESCRIPTION: FM 5051-ES is an effective general herbicide for use on non-cropland areas for control of brush, undesirable weeds and grasses.

APPLICATION: This concentrate is an effective general herbicide for use on non-cropland areas for control of brush and many annual and perennial weeds, and is particularly useful for control of perennial grasses. It is a water soluble liquid to be mixed in water and applied as a spray; this concentrate may be applied undiluted for basal (soil) treatment of brush. Effects are slow to appear and may not become apparent until the chemical has been carried into the root zone of the weeds by moisture. The degree of control and duration of effects will vary with the amount of chemical applied, soil type, rainfall, and other conditions.

DIRECTIONS: IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING. Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants in non-crop and non-timber areas only. Not for use on crops, timber, or other plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:** This product is a liquid non-selective, general herbicide which is designed to be used where control of all vegetation is desired. Translocation and root absorption produce extensive root kill of weeds and provides long term control. Sufficient moisture from rainfall or artificial means is necessary after treatment to carry the chemical into the roots of the weeds. This product is recommended for non-crop areas such as RAILROADS, HIGHWAYS, PIPELINES, TANK FARMS, LUMBER YARDS, FENCE ROWS and PARKING LOTS. This concentrate can be sprayed or sprinkled on. If sprayed, direct the spray to the soil at the base of the weeds and adjust for coarse spray to prevent drifting. Thoroughly clean spray equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes or do not use same equipment for other purposes. Do not re-use this container for other purposes. **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS:** For easy application and better penetration, dilute one gallon of concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply as directed below. **ANNUAL WEEDS AND GRASSES:** Such as Crabgrass, Foxtail Ryegrass, Wild Oats, Broomgrass, Lambsquarter, and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 1500 square feet (290 gal./acre). **PERENNIAL WEEDS AND GRASSES:** Such as Smooth Brome, Quackgrass, Bluegrass, Purple Top Dandelion, Goldenrod, Wild Carrot and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 800 square feet (544 gal./acre). No retreatment allowed within a twelve month period of application. **HARD TO KILL PERENNIALS:** Such as Johnsongrass, Bermuda grass, Dallisgrass, Nutgrass, Saltgrass, Dogbane, Horsetail, Bracken Fern, and similar weeds. Use 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 800 square feet (544 gal./acre). No retreatment allowed within a twelve month period of application. **RETREATMENT:** Apply 10 gallons of the diluted concentrate per 1,500 square feet when Annual Weeds and Grasses reappear.

PRECAUTIONS: **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Hazardous to Humans and Domestic Animals. **CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. **PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE):** Applicators and other handlers must wear: Chemical-resistant gloves (Category A); Long-sleeved shirt and long pants; shoes plus socks. **USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:** Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry. **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

FIRST AID: IF ON SKIN: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. **IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. **IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
