Use our scraper/squeegee to push ice to the side and then, if desired, turn the scraper around and use the squeegee to remove all traces of ice and product from windshields or door jams, resulting in a clean ice-free surface.

Even thick layers of ice will not stick to surfaces treated with Prevent-A-Freeze. Effective to -25°F.

DESCRIPTION: A truly unique, ready-to-use material designed to cling to any vertical or sloped surface—Foremost 663-ES Prevent-A-Freeze will completely stop ice adhesion or buildup even at 25° below zero. This remarkable product has been formulated with the chemistry of the new millennium, allowing it to be applied through low pressure equipment such as trigger or pump-up sprayers. Yet, through a process known as rheology rebound, Foremost 663-ES thickens instantly upon hitting the surface, forming an ice-proof shield. Prevent-A-Freeze is 100% biodegradable and is virtually nontoxic to humans, plants, or animals. It is noncorrosive and will not harm rubber tires, metal, rubber, asphalt, glass, concrete, wood, or painted surfaces.

APPLICATION: Recommended especially for use on windshields, car door locks, around car door edges—anywhere that ice may build up and cause problems on those cold winter mornings. Used by Highway Maintenance crews, Utility workers, and Railroad employees to prevent ice from sticking to critical equipment such as snow plows and mechanical switches.

DIRECTIONS: To prevent ice from bonding prior to sleet or snow storms, simply spray using a trigger sprayer or pump-up sprayer onto the appropriate surface in a thin film. No need to apply heavily. In the morning, the ice and snow will slide from the surface—no more gouging and scraping—no more frozen car door locks—no more struggling to pull open the car door.

For car windshields, a squeegee or rag should be used to remove the last traces of Prevent-A-Freeze to provide a crystal clear, ice-free view of the road ahead. On side windows, use a much lighter coating to avoid dried residue obscuring vision.

For existing ice: for solids or glazed ice: to speed action, scratch or score in several places and spray full strength, into scratches. It will penetrate quickly, and break the bond, making ice easier to scoop or scrape away.

PRECAUTIONS: **KEEP THIS AND ALL OTHER INDUSTRIAL MATERIALS OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN.** Contains propylene glycol. Keep container closed. May cause minor eye and skin irritation. Do not take internally.
