# TECHNICAL DATA

## FOREMOST 703-US BLUE BRUTE

**DESCRIPTION:** A low foam, concentrated liquid cleaner with alkaline builders, formulated for fast, efficient removal of oil, grease bonded soils, grime, waxes, cutting oils; adhesives, syrups, soot, soft carbon, blood stains and lube oils. It contains detergent plus solvent action boosted with emulsifiers and wetting agents combined to deliver fast and thorough cleaning that ordinary cleaners miss.

**APPLICATION:** Foremost 703-US Blue Brute has proven highly effective for general cleaning, power spray, floor scrubbing machines, steam cleaning and manual cleaning in industry, food processors, institutions, automotive, building maintenance and restaurants. It is recommended for use in floor scrubbing machines for all composition flooring which requires safe and efficient cleaning and removal of water wax.

**DIRECTIONS:** **FOR POWER SPRAY OR STEAM CLEANING:**

1. Charge solution tank with one part of Foremost 703-US Blue Brute to 5-80 parts water depending on severity of soiling.
2. After cleaning, rinse with clean water.

**FOR MANUAL USE:**

1. Dilute the concentrate with 5-80 parts water, depending on severity of soiling.
2. Apply solution to surface by spraying, brush or mop.
3. Agitate, if needed or simply:
4. Rinse or wipe off.

**FOR AUTO FLOOR SCRUB OR WAX SCRUB:**

1. Dilute approximately 1 part with 20 parts warm water.
2. Apply the solution with the floor scrubbing machine using a #3 steel wool or synthetic scrubbing pad under the machine.
3. If desired, application may be made by machine, allowing 10 minutes to soften wax, then remove with a scrubbing pad under the machine.

**NOTE:** Not recommended for cleaning glass. If incidental contact occurs, rinse immediately with water.

**CAUTION ON ALUMINUM:** Always dilute with at least 10 parts water. Do not clean in direct sun or hot surface. Do not allow excessive contact time as etching might occur.

**PRECAUTIONS:** **KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Contains sodium silicate, and ethylene glycol monobutyl ether. May cause eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. No irritation is likely following short contact periods with human skin. Prolonged and/or repeated exposure may lead to redness, swelling or irritation. Do not take internally.

**FIRST AID: EYES:** In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. **SKIN:** In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water.
